Priest        We give you thanks and praise for sending us Jesus.  
                  He was born of a woman  
                  Who made an ordinary home become a place  
                  for the Christ to blossom in Jesus.  
                  He ate and drank with tax collectors and sinners.  
                  He called us to love our enemies,  
                  and pray for those who are against us.  
                  When he submitted himself to die on the cross  
                  he called all who follow him to turn the other cheek,  
                  and not return violence with violence.  
                  In all things he taught us how to love.

                  One night he appeared behind a locked door to his disciples  
                  and said to them, "peace be with you."  
                  Then he breathed on them,  
                  and bestowed upon them the Holy Spirit.

                  When a life of courage  
                  Lived so close to your own heart  
                  was coming to an end,  
                  Jesus, while at supper with friends,  
                  took bread, blessed it,  
                  broke it and offered it to them saying,
